Wild & Scenic Rafting Trip

(approx. 3 hours) Adult \$56 Child \$35 (6-11)

Enjoy a 10-mile raft trip on the scenic Snake River which offers a close-up look at the unique habitat of the area as well as spectacular views of the Tetons. Our experienced river guides will share the human and natural history of the valley, while you enjoy the views and catch a glimpse of wildlife along the way, which may include bald eagles, moose, bison, elk, pronghorn, osprey, great blue heron black and grizzly bears.

Wild & Scenic Rafting Trips are scheduled daily with morning, afternoon and early evening departures.

Wild & Scenic Luncheon Rafting Trip
